RAC Funding Mechanisms

Start-Up Grant

- New faculty within five seven years of appointment
- Maximum funding \$80,000 over two years

Seed Grant

Maximum funding \$40,000 for one year; a second year is possible with satisfactory progress

Fellowship Grant

Awards are for one year only

Graduate Student Grant


- Full-time University of Pittsburgh graduate students
- Maximum funding limited to two years for graduate stipend and fringe benefits

Bridge

- Provides support when there is a gap in external funding
- One-year maximum

Pilot Translational Grant


- Clinical or basic-to-clinical translational research to develop preliminary observations
- Maximum funding \$25,000 one year









- 45 students were selected from 242 applicants
